

# PROCEEDINGS OF THE LITTLE SUAMICO PARK COMMITTEE

September 2, 2008

1. **Call to Order:** Keith Helmle called the meeting to order at 6:30PM
2. **Approval of Agenda:** A motion to approve the agenda was made by Bill Ahnen, seconded by Sara Arndt, unanimously approved, and motion carried.
3. **Approval of Minutes:** A motion to approve the June 2, 2008 meeting minutes was made by Sara Arndt, seconded by Bill Ahnen, unanimously approved, and motion carried.
4. **Communications:** None
5. **UWGB Soccer Programs:** Mike Kulas and Darren Gallagher, assistant UWGB soccer coaches, presented proposals for soccer clinics (ages 5-13) at Little Suamico Park to be run by UWGB and the FC Green Bay Soccer Club.

Plans were made for a one evening clinic in October. UWGB would supply an electronic version of a flyer. Little Suamico would produce copies of the flyer and distribute to Pulaski (Sunnyside Elem., Middle School), Oconto Falls (Abrams, Middle School) and, possibly, Lena and Oconto Schools. Little Suamico would be responsible for the goals and lining the fields.

Other future possibilities would be:

UWGB soccer game – Little Suamico Night

One day clinic – spring 2009

One-week clinic – early June 2009

Three day camp – late July 2009.

6. **Town Update:** No discussion.

7. **Concession/Restroom Facilities:** The plans and specifications (“P&S”) for the Abrams concession/restroom building built in 2005 will be used to obtain bids for a new building. Keith Helmle will review the “P&S” with Elmer Ragen later this week and a bidder list will be determined. Bids are expected by the next (October 6<sup>th</sup>) Park Committee Meeting. Land use, building, and sanitary permits will be required.  
It may be possible to combine the remaining 2008 park funds with 2009 park funds to construct a new building early next spring.

Dale Pinkston reviewed with the Committee pictures and preliminary bids he obtained from BMS, Inc. (Fort Collins, CO). These units are factory assembled, trucked to the job site, and set on a concrete foundation. Prices range from about \$100,000 - \$150,000. Dale will pursue sending BMS the “P&S” to obtain a bid.

8. **Improvements for 2008:** Picnic tables near the playground will be postponed and discussed again in 2009.
9. **Questions and Comments from the Public:** None.
10. **Adjourn:** A motion to adjourn was made by Sara Arndt, seconded by Gary Pusick, unanimously approved, and motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 7:58PM.
