Agenda was read by the Chairman. Motion made by David E. Pribyl to accept the Agenda as read. Seconded by Douglas Allen. Motion Carried. Ayes - 3 Nays - 0.

Dave asked about the 16 acre soccer field if that whole thing should be cut or only half since it is not being used. Discussion followed and decided that it would be cut for this year and see how it will go, if there will be and soccer games or not.

Tom Bonk asked asked if there are any tournaments scheduled for the park and what do they pay for rent so the town comes out for the lights and other cost. Chairman explained what they pay, etc.

John Williams gave an update on the Planning Commission and what has been going on. The town is housecleaning and doing administrative changes and updates. On drive-ways, roads, successive planning, transitions for a different town board when that day comes. The town goes through the county for the use of their SOLO program, aerial maps, flood plain maps, what the land is zoned as, etc. and to get the town more prioritized. Someday the town should look into a LOGO to identify the town. We are moving forward because things are changing fast.

Chairman told about the new law of prevailing wages and what that will do to the town when building new roads or building a building.
