Eight people from Havenwood Hills are concerned about break-in's in that  
area and would like to know what they could do or what the town could do.  
Oconto Co. has one officer for this zone and it is a large area to police. They  
do have Neighborhood watch in this area and there are some that are  
following suspicious vehicles and are concerned for the safety of the home  
owners doing these things on their own. Complained that the people who  
drive in there just looking are driving faster than 25 MPH.

The chairman stated there has been police officers out there when they are  
called and sometimes patrolling also. Also stated the Oconto Co., will have  
to cut their budget but hopefully not in the Sheriffs dept.

Chairman will check to see what can be done about the old Lucas place on  
E. Frontage Rd. There is a lot of activity with kids breaking windows and  
graffiti all over the outside of the house and having parties there also.  
Would like to get State and Federal money that the town could get more law  
enforcement .
