Wisconsin Statutes 350 they must be off of the road right-of-way 10'. You must go with the traffic at night time and during the day you can go opposite of the traffic. Check into your covenants in your subdivision to see if there is anything about riding snowmobiles on the right-of-ways.

Any shoulder are open to snowmobiles but must stay off 10' from right-of-way. Suamico has made their portion of Brown Road a snowmobile route already and they can go over the overpass. Would like to know if they can go on the shoulder on the Little Suamico side. Chairman will check with the lawyer on this.

Planning Committee – Got the minutes and everything is going along fine.

Cottage Rd. update - having a the last meeting to inform the people of what is happening on Cottage Rd. this will be Dec. 10 at 7:00 p.m.

Park – Dec. 22 will be the bid opening for the new concession building.
